
Getting to the 74th NSDC in Shreveport

You've registered for the 74th National Square Dance Convention to be held June 25-28, 2025 in Shreveport, LA. Now, how do you get here?

- DRIVING** – Shreveport is located in the Ark-La-Tex region in the northwest corner of Louisiana, approximately 30 miles from both Texas and Arkansas. Situated at the intersection of Interstate-20 and I-49, travel by car to Shreveport is easy from any direction.
- PARKING** - Should you opt to drive your own vehicle or a rental to the Shreveport Convention Center, parking once you arrive at the Shreveport Hilton parking garage is low cost at \$4/day with in and out privileges. You also have the option of parking at either Sam's Town or Bally's Casino parking structures at no charge, a 10-minute walk from the 74th NSDC.
- SHREVEPORT REGIONAL AIRPORT (SHV)** – The convention city is served by a mid-sized airport with service by American, Delta, United and Allegiant Air, which is the only low-cost carrier with limited destinations and days for arrivals and departures. The SHV website is <http://www.flyshreveport.com>. Other low-cost options can be found in Dallas, TX, either at DFW (Dallas Fort Worth) or DAL (Dallas Love Field), headquarters for Southwest Airlines. Dallas is approximately 188 miles from Shreveport, about 3 hours by rental car.
- AMTRAK** – Amtrak train run from locations across the country. Additionally, if flying into Dallas, one can ride the Amtrak Texas Eagle from the Dallas Eddie Bernice Johnson Union Station to Longview, TX, with a final destination to Shreveport as low as \$26 pp round trip, less if you are 65+ years of age. Upon arrival by train in Longview, an exclusive Amtrak motorcoach drives you into Shreveport at no additional charge. There is only one train per day either direction, so plan accordingly. Upon arriving at the Shreveport Intermodal Terminal, it's a short 1.6 miles by taxi or ride share to the Hilton Convention Center Hotel or Sam's Town Casino. If you opt to travel via Amtrak from your home location to Shreveport, depending on your service area, Amtrak does offer a hefty discount for groups of 8 or more all traveling on the same schedule.
- TAXI AND RIDE SHARE** – Shreveport taxi options include: Action Taxi, VIP Taxi, White Morris Transport, and Yellow Checker Cab.
